Introduction

No one likes to throw things away when someone else might be able to use them or when the items are still worth money. But sometimes it seems like a lot of extra work to find a good home for these leftover items.

To help, we've created this guide — it's full of ideas to keep stuff out of the garbage and maybe even put some money in your pocket. We've researched organizations, services and businesses that buy, sell, repair and rent consumer goods, and we've listed them in this directory.

About half of the Lower Mainland's waste is recycled, and we're working to further redirect usable items from the waste stream. It is essential to practice the 3Rs (reduce, reuse, recycle) wherever possible, to continue reducing the waste we create. Zero waste is the ultimate goal.

"Reusing" is a key element in waste reduction; it means using an item again and again, or using it for another purpose. Reusing helps conserve our natural resources — including land space — and saves you money!

This guide is organized into separate sections on various household items like books, clothing and furniture. Sections include ideas and tips for finding new uses for your goods, followed by a directory of organizations, services and business that buy, sell, repair or rent items.

Ways to reuse: Principles and practices

Save time and money by making the "reuse" philosophy part of your life. Put your imagination and creativity to work!

Buy quality

- Purchase durable goods rather than disposable items. Good quality items last longer, and have better re-sale value.
- Buy good-quality, long-lasting clothing.
 If styles change, alter or donate the pieces.
- Inform yourself: read consumer magazines and contact consumer organizations before making a major purchase.
- When you can, buy a product made of recycled material.



Rent

- Rent or borrow, rather than purchase, seldom-used items such as tools and party supplies.
- Rent a tool or major appliance first to determine whether or not you need it. Check your yellow phone directory under "Rental Services — General" for more information.

Use it again

- Buy used items.
- Save and reuse household items plastic and glass containers, gift wrap and shopping bags.





Repair and share

- Don't throw it away: fix it. Maintain and repair broken toys, furniture and appliances to extend their life
- Chip in with others to buy large, expensive items you use only once in a while.

Donate


 Donate items of good quality to charities and organizations that can reuse or resell them.


Refill

Refill your bottles and other containers.
 Laundry detergent, shampoo or pop containers can be used more than once, and for other things.

Dismantle

• Take objects apart into individual components for recycling and reuse. For example, remove the pedals and wheels of a bike, so you can recycle the metal frame.





Ways to resell: Principles and practices

If you can't reuse it, someone else probably can!

Instead of keeping items that clutter your space, find a new home for things you no longer want or need.

Use notice boards

- If you only have a few items, put up a notice at work, at recreation centres and at libraries. If you have more than a few items, place an advertisement in the classified section of your local newspaper.
- Electronic bulletin boards or websites that cater to secondhand goods are also good places to post notices.
- Make sure your notice includes your telephone number and details about your item, including the price.
- Remove all your notices after everything is sold.

Advertise in the classified section

- Review the category numbers used in the classified section index of the newspaper you plan to use. When you place your advertisement, quote the category number under which you wish to list your items. Name and describe the item and include a price.
- If you have a number of items to sell, list them under "Miscellaneous" rather than under separate headings.
- Community newspapers often have lower rates or a special "Free" column for advertising items you want to give away. Or check the "Wanted" column to find someone who wants what you have.

Clutter getting you down? Plan a garage sale!

Garage sales can be a profitable and fun way to clear your clutter. Here are a few tips for a successful sale:

Pick a date

 Make sure the date doesn't conflict with a holiday or special event. Weekends yield better success than weekdays.

Bigger is better

 Check with friends, family and neighbours to see if they would like to join you, or if they have anything for you to sell on their behalf. More people means less work, and more items mean more shoppers! Share on advertising costs to increase profit margins.

Best sellers

- Appliances, furniture, toys, dishes and other practical household items are popular.
- Clothing does not usually have a high resale value; kids' clothing (arranged by size) is the exception.
- Make sure your items are clean and in working condition; if they're not, then clearly state their condition.
- If you have miscellaneous items you think may not sell, put them in a "free" box.
- If you have a truck, consider offering free delivery for big items to nearby homes customer service sells.

Promotion

 Advertise in the classified section of your community paper, or in the newspaper read most often by people in your area.

• In your ad include the date, time (start early since most sales end by 2 p.m.), address, and list some of the more desirable or unique items.

 Signage—remember, garage "salers" are in moving vehicles, so make large signs that are easy to read. The date, time and address should be the focus.

 Use coloured paper for signs. Use large, clear print. Put posters on bulletin boards in grocery stores, libraries, laundromats and other public areas. SAT., MAY 3
PAM TO HPM
193 YOUR ST.

Remember to remove and reuse/recycle your signs!

- Put signs at the intersection closest to your house, in front of your house, and on the main streets near your house.
- Make signs for goods displayed at your sale, for example, "Housewares," "Kids Clothes," "Giftware," etc. Make a sign that reads "Reduced Prices" and post it halfway through your sale.

Rainy day

- Consider putting up a tarp, or holding your sale under cover.
- Waterproof your signs by laminating them, or wrapping them in clear plastic bags.

Set fair prices

- If you are not sure how to price your items, visit local thrift stores or garage sales to get a good idea. Don't price your items too low initially, because people will bargain with you.
- Price everything using masking tape or removable stickers, or sort items by price and post signs, "This table \$1 to \$2." This saves you from inventing prices on the spot.
- Be flexible, accept reasonable offers, and consider "throwing in" related items.
- If you're having a group sale, use different coloured tags, and record sales by colour so you can correctly divide the money at the end of the day.
- Have lots of coins and small bills ready.

Make it social

- Send invitations or e-mails to friends and family.
- If you have a street sale with your neighbours, have a BBQ afterward.
- Have kids from the neighbourhood arrange a lemonade stand, or sell coffee and doughnuts to encourage people to stay longer and socialize.

It's sale day!

- Expect early birds, so clear all paths and move the car(s) out of the driveway.
- Display goods in an organized and attractive way on tables, boxes, or even the lawn. Group similar items together, and place clothes on hangers along a fence or coat rack.
- Have an electrical outlet or extension cord accessible if you are selling electronics. Buyers may want to test items.

Sell, sell, sell any which way you can! Remember: you've got to pack up everything that doesn't sell!

- Cover or remove items that are not for sale to prevent potential theft and avoid unwanted offers on your prized patio furniture or lawnmower.
- Offer laundry hampers or durable bags as shopping baskets to encourage browsing.
- Provide extra bags and boxes for shoppers to take their purchases home.
- Keep the money with you at all times, or assign one person to handle the cash.
 Remember to lock your house.
- Have a great day relax and remember your sense of humour.

Clean up time

- After the sale is over, remove all your signs from around the neighbourhood.
- Donate leftover items to charity, or try selling them at a flea market.

Garage Sale Checklist

Planning ahead:

- Pick the date and start early in the morning
- See if neighbours or friends want to join
- □ Collect and clean goods for selling
- □ Gather items for a "free box"
- □ Label and price items

One week prior:

- Place an ad in classified section of the newspaper
- Make signs and post around neighbourhood
- Get lots of coins and small bills to make change

Night before:

- Prepare tables
- Place clothes on hangers
- ☑ Group similar items
- Make sure all items are priced
- Put up signs (street, intersection, displays)

Sale day:

- Ensure access to electrical outlets
- Remove or cover items not for sale
- Have laundry hampers, shopping bags and boxes ready

After the sale:

- Remove signs and posters
- Donate leftover items to charity





Books, magazines & comic books TIPS

Borrow rather than buy. Check your local library and friends to try new authors and subjects without worrying about cost or the storage space. In turn, lend your used books and magazines to friends, or donate them to a library, community centre, senior citizens' home, or charity.

Buy books at used bookstores and thrift stores. Check university and student society bookstores for used textbooks.

Share a magazine or newspaper subscription with a friend

Start a book club and share the cost on the latest bestsellers.

Read the news online, listen to it on the radio, or watch the daily newscast. Check your local library or at work for daily papers.



Donate used children's books to other

families, women's shelters, daycares, schools or the local hospital children's ward.



Organize a book swap event with friends, family, co-workers and neighbours. Donate leftover books.

TIPS

Buy and sell building and decorating materials and tools at garage sales, demolition sales or building supply outlets. Check the yellow phone directory under "Building Materials – Used."

Rent, borrow or share tools that you only need occasionally, like roto-tillers, post-hole diggers and sanders. Check the yellow phone directory under "Rental Services – General" for more information.

Recycle old or leftover paint, gasoline, solvents and pesticides at your local paint and product care recycling depot. Call the RCBC Recycling Hotline at 604-732-9253, or visit www.productcare.com.



Use leftover paint on old furniture, an old fence, the inside of your garage or for touch-ups.

Refinish a piece of furniture by sanding it and applying a new stain or paint colour. Use existing furniture or pick up a new piece at a garage sale or second-hand store.

Check references of contractors and builders; ask friends and family for recommendations.

Old fabric has new uses. Draperies or bedspreads can turn into new cushions, placemats or costumes.

Reduce workshop waste. Add thin layers of dampened (not chemically-treated) sawdust to your compost bin to cut down on workshop waste. Sand pieces of wood to make a set of children's building blocks and finish with lead-free paint or oil. You'll reduce garbage and end up with an original gift.

Reuse old household items in the garden. For example, use an old broom handle or pieces of moulding and pipe as garden stakes.

Non-invasive native plants cut down on water, fertilizer needs and other maintenance.

Reuse broken or old garden tools in new ways. For example, use a leaky hose as a soaker hose by punching holes along its length, or use an old wheelbarrow, washstand, or barrel as a plant container. Find out if your local garden centre can reuse your flower trays, pots and containers.


